Kadri Gopalnath is one of the pioneers of Carnatic music on the saxophone. It took him nearly 20 years to master the western wind instrument. He had to modify the conventional alto saxophone to play Carnatic music. Gopalnath has toured worldwide, and participated in the Jazz Festivals in Prague and Berlin, the Music Hall Festival in Paris, and the BBC Promenade concert in London. His numerous honors include Asthana Vidwan of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam. He was awarded the Padma Shri in 2004
